#### Nowhere in Israel Have I Found as Much Faith Mark J. Mahal – Funeral Director

The Lord Jesus agreed to go to the centurion's house to cure his servant, but he replied: I am not worthy to have you under my roof; only say the word and my servant will be healed. In protesting his unworthiness the centurion showed himself worthy to have Christ enter not his house but his heart. Yet he could not have said this with such faith and humility unless he already bore within his heart the One he was too overawed to have within his house. In any case, there would have been no great happiness at the entry of the Lord Jesus within his walls if he were not present in his heart.

But what emboldened the centurion to act as he did? I am under authority myself, he said, and have soldiers under me; and I say to one man, Go, and he goes; to another, Come here, and he comes; to my servant, Do this, and he does it.

Now the man who said this was a Gentile as well as a centurion. He was a professional soldier and, as a centurion, acted according to his rank: subject to authority and exercise in authority, obeying as a subordinate and giving orders to those subordinate to him. As for the Lord, though living among the Jewish people, He was already beginning to make it known that His Church would extend throughout the whole world into which He was about to send His apostles. Although the Gentiles would not see him they would believe in him, whereas the Jewish leaders who saw him would put him to death.



HILARY; Spiritually interpreted, the Gentiles are the sick in this world, and afflicted with the diseases of sin, all their limbs being altogether unnerved, and unfit for their duties of standing and walking. The sacrament of their salvation is fulfilled in this centurion's servant. of whom it is sufficiently declared that he was the head of the Gentiles that should believe. What sort of head this is, the song of Moses in Deuteronomy teaches. He set the bounds of the people according to the number of the Angels.

JEROME; The Lord seeing the centurion's faith, humbleness, and thoughtfulness, straightway promises to go and heal him; Jesus says to him, I will come and heal him.

CHRYS. Jesus here does what He never did; He always follows the wish of the supplicant, but here He goes before it, and not only promises to heal him, but to go to his house. This He does, that we may learn the worthiness of the centurion.

AUG. By declaring himself unworthy, he showed himself worthy, not indeed into whose house, But into whose heart, Christ the Word of God should enter. Nor could He have said this with so much faith and humility, had he not borne in his heart Him whom he feared to have in his house. And indeed, it would have been no great blessedness that Jesus should enter within his walls, if He had not already entered into his heart.


Sing praise to God, sing praise! Sing praise to our King, sing praise Prokimenon, Resurrection Tone Three.

A man or woman who acts as a fortune teller shall be put to death by stoning; they have no one else to blame for their death Leviticus 20: 27

I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, that place of slavery. You shall have no other gods beside me. You shall not carve idols for yourselves in the shape of anything in the sky above or on the earth below or in the waters beneath the earth; you shall not bow down before them or worship them. For, I, the Lord your God am a jealous God, inflicting punishment for their fathers' wickedness on the children of those who hate me, down to the third and fourth generation; but bestowing mercy down to the thousandth generation, on the children of those who love me and keep my commandments Exodus 20: 2-6.

When you come into the land the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to imitate the abominations of the prophets there. Let there not be fund among you ... a fortune teller, soothsayer, charmer, diviner or caster of spells nor one who consults ghosts and spirits or seeks oracles from the dead. Anyone who does these things is an abomination to the Lord Deuteronomy 18: 9 – 12.

Lies these prophets utter in my name, the Lord said to me. I did not send them. I give them no command nor did I speak to them. Lying visions, foolish divination, dreams of their own imagination, they prophesy to you. ... The people, to whom they prophesy shall be cast out into the streets of Jerusalem by famine and sword Jeremiah 14: 14 – 16.

You did not build a wall about the house of Israel that would stand firm against attack on the day of the Lord. Was not the vision you saw false, and your divination lying? Therefore, thus says the Lord God: Because you have spoken falsehood and have seen lying visions, therefore see! I am coming at you, says the Lord God. Ezekiel 13: 5 – 8.
